Scholarship Information & Procedures

Eligibility Rules for the Avalt Meyer Memorial Tri-Club Scholarship:

- 1. Each applicant must be a graduating high school senior enrolled in Spring ISD.
- 2. Each applicant must have participated as an active member of FCCLA, 4-H, or FFA **AND** have exhibited in the Spring Livestock Show for at least two (2) years as a high school student. One of which must have been in your senior year.
- 3. Each applicant must submit an Avalt Meyer Memorial Tri-Club Scholarship application form, a copy of the applicant's high school transcript, a non-returnable wallet-size photograph and a one page typed letter outlining the reason(s) why the applicant should be considered as a scholarship recipient.
- 4. Each applicant must be personally interviewed by the Avalt Meyer Memorial Tri-Club Scholarship representatives. Interviews will be held in April from 6:00 to 9:00 p.m. in the Portable Building near the Spring ISD Nagy Pavilion on W. Hardy Rd. at Lemm Rd. #1. Applicants will be notified by phone of the scheduled day and time of their interview.
- 5. Each applicant must have applied to a full four year college, an approved junior college or vocational school. Remember, you must have done this. VERY IMPORTANT.
- 6. The recipient must submit a copy of paid tuition showing a minimum of twelve credit hours by **October 1**st of the year the scholarship is awarded to receive the first half of the awarded scholarship. To receive the second half of the awarded scholarship the recipient must submit a copy of their paid tuition showing a minimum of twelve credit hours and a copy of their fall transcript showing a 2.5 grade point average or better for the fall semester. This must be submitted by **March 1**st for the Spring semester. If these requirements are not met, the funds will not be distributed and will be returned back into the Avalt Meyer Memorial Tri-Club Scholarship Fund.

Attached you will find a copy of the Avalt Meyer Memorial Tri-Club Scholarship. The Meyer family has decided to honor Mr. Meyer by providing one \$500 scholarship in honor of his memory to a graduating senior who is a Spring Tri-Club participant.

Avalt Meyer was instrumental in helping establish Tri-Club and was honored as Tri-Club's 50th Year Honoree. Mr. Meyer was the original Vegetable Committee Chairperson in the early 1960's as well as the Barbeque Chairperson.
